NARRATIVE

On Tuesday, December 29th, 2009 at approximately 2:22 AM I responded to 1831 55th Terr SW Unit C in reference to a medical call involving a three month old infant who was not conscious nor breathing.

Upon arrival, I entered the apartment with Cpl. Alexander #2733, and Cpl. Pedraza #2554, and immediately began administering first aid. I observed the infant laying on a bed in the right rear master bedroom. The infant was warm to the touch and slightly blue in color. After clearing the infant's airway and assuring that no pulse was felt, I began infant CPR. I gave several chest compressions while an AED was being prepared. After the infant chest pads from the AED were attached to the front and rear of the infant's chest area the AED gave an audible verbal command not to shock. After hearing this alert I continued infant CPR. While I was administering infant CPR, EMS arrived and took over chest compressions and continued first aid for the infant. EMS then transported the infant to Physician's Regional Medical Center located at 6101 Pine Ridge Rd to receive further medical aid.

As the infant was being treated, I stayed with the infant's father, Benjamin Garcia. A crime scene was established and no one was allowed into the rear master bedroom.

While speaking with Benjamin regarding what occurred he stated the following:

Benjamin began feeding Christian, via a bottle with formula, at approximately 12:00 AM. Benjamin said that he placed Christian in his crib and placed two pillows on top of his chest and propped the bottle up against them to allow Christian to eat. While Christian was eating, Benjamin said that he laid down on his bed and watched a movie. During the movie Benjamin fell asleep. He woke up approximately one to one and a half hours later. He said he smelled the odor of poop coming from Christian's diaper so he lifted Christian from the crib and placed him on the bed. After Benjamin finished changing Christian's diaper, he noticed that Christian was lifeless. Benjamin said he then began compressions on Christian's stomach and observed formula coming out of his mouth. Benjamin then gave Christian a rescue breath and observed more formula coming from his nose. Benjamin called Christian's mother, Shannon; however she did not answer. Benjamin then [REDACTED] Benjamin said that before he could begin CPR deputies arrived.

While I was at the scene, Cpl. Pedraza and other deputies went to the hospital and awaited arrival of the mother, Shannon. While at the hospital, deputies were advised that Christian passed away.

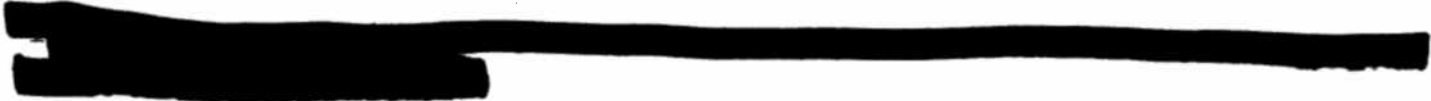
